Cold Process Soapmaking 101

What you will learn:

- Learn the basics of making cold-process soap from scratch. Students will learn about the history, process, tools and ingredients. Then join your instructors, Dave and Sonja, around the soap pot to make soap. Students will take home two bars made at the class and an instruction booklet. **Cold process classes are limited to 7 people each class.**
- Properties and soap qualities and how to formulate your own recipe
- How to use herbs and natural ingredients
- Instruction manual
- Two bars of soap
- The knowledge to go forward in the exciting world of soapmaking!

Available Items:

- We will have a small "soapmaking kit" available for \$99, which includes everything needed to make soap at home. This includes instructions, recipe, stick blender, soap mold, lye, oils, essential oils, botanicals, goggles, gloves, thermometer, and spatulas. This is **for the serious soapmaker!**

What to bring: For this class you need to bring safety goggles, rubber gloves, apron and a clean, empty plastic food container with top to take your soap home in. (Tupperware will work as well) Make sure to use something that you will NOT use for food again!

Course prerequisites are:

- You must be 18 years old. Working with lye, which is very caustic, is dangerous, so we ask that **no pets or children** come unless there is someone to take care of them during process in another room.
- An ability and desire to stand in a kitchen for 3-4 hours.
- Making soap requires the handling of a known caustic
- You must be in good health with no respiratory ailments.
- Prepayment in full for the course
